What we are looking for:

LRISS is creating a list of eligible contractors that could deliver our field program. The work includes inventory, surveys and mechanical treatment of invasives in the Lillooet Region. Preference will be given to those that have direct experience collecting data using the Invasive Alien Plant Program's (IAPP) methodology. LRISS requires that the contractor has their own transportation to travel to sites on 4x4 roads in addition to the basic equipment to collect data and remove invasives. All removal will be done mechanically (ie. digging, hand-pulling, cutting etc).

Eligible contractors will be placed on a list and contacted regarding opportunities for work.

Preferred Skills & Competencies:

- Invasive species knowledge.
- Experience with field inventory and sampling IAPP
- At least one team member with a Natural Resource degree or diploma.
- Competency using technology in the field like GPS and IPads.

Other Desired Assets:

- Work Safe BC coverage
- Valid DL & vehicle with appropriate liability coverage for field work.
